To achieve success, one must exit the state of survival. Become present and available in the here and now. When you leave the state of survival, you can see your life with clarity and possibilities and operate from a state of flow.

"Not everyone needs to go to college, but everyone needs an education." The Latino community is the fastest-growing population in the US. The US Census estimated 60.1 Hispanics as of 2020.
